Two motor vehicle collisions have been reported to Police with total property damage estimated at \$2000.00. As a result two motorists have been charged with following too closely and will appear in court on February 3rd.

On January 15, a motorist was checked by officers on patrol and the driver could not produce evidence of insurance. He was subsequently charged under the Motor vehicle Accident Claims Act.

During the week, three juveniles have been cautioned regarding the operation of their snowmobiles.

Section 8(2) of the Motorized Snow Vehicles Act reads as follows - No person shall drive a motorized snow vehicle across a highway unless, (a) he has attained the full age of fourteen years; and (b) he holds a driver's licence, a motorized snow vehicle operator's licence or is a resident of any other province, country or state and holds a licence issued by such province, country of state which authorizes him to drive a motorized snow vehicle.
