AUXILIARY TO THE McCAUSLAND HOSPITAL ANNUAL REPORT 1976

The annual meeting was held January 17, 1977 in the library of St. Martin School in Terrace Bay. Reports reviewed the major fund raising projects of 1976, showing that a total of \$5,284.03 had been raised. The membership drive brought in \$1724.00. The McCausland Hospital Gift Shop raised \$600.00 for the general account, \$500.00 for the cardiac monitor and purchased new drapes for the hospital. The sale of rags brought in \$121.00. The Arts and Craft Show and Bake Sale during the Winter Carnival raised a total of \$306.85. Raffles raised \$133.00. The Annual Spring-Ball, "A Touch of Spring", held on May 7th in conjunction with Hospital Week made a profit of \$704.67. The Cooking School made a profit of \$585.00 since all expenses were absorbed by Costa's Foodmarkets.

These projects plus the 1975 halance of \$1109.51 gave the grand total of \$5,284.00. The disbursements were as follows: 1. donated to the McCausland Hospital Building Fund \$3,579.00.2. Donated to the McCausland Hospital to be used toward the purchase of the cardiac monitor \$1000. 3. expenses for redecorating the children's ward \$51.71 and 4. operating expenses \$78.92. Thus total debits were \$4,709.63 leaving a cash balance of \$574.40 to enter 1977.

Norma Crockford took office and thanked the members of the 1976 executive for their past service. Then business proceeded to current projects.




