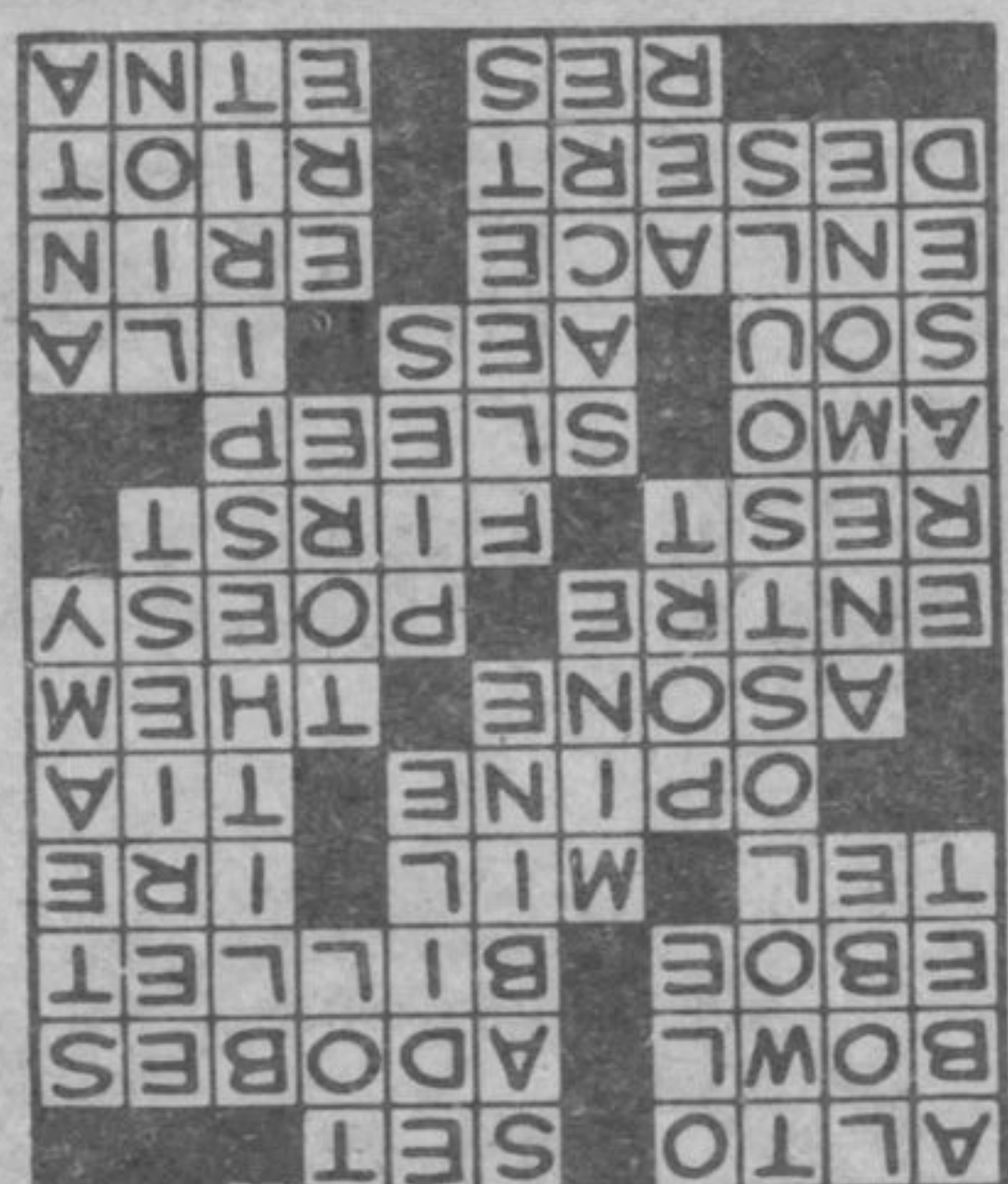
This year the Community Church will be hosting the World Day of Prayer Service in March.

The meeting was closed with prayer. Lunch was served after the meeting.

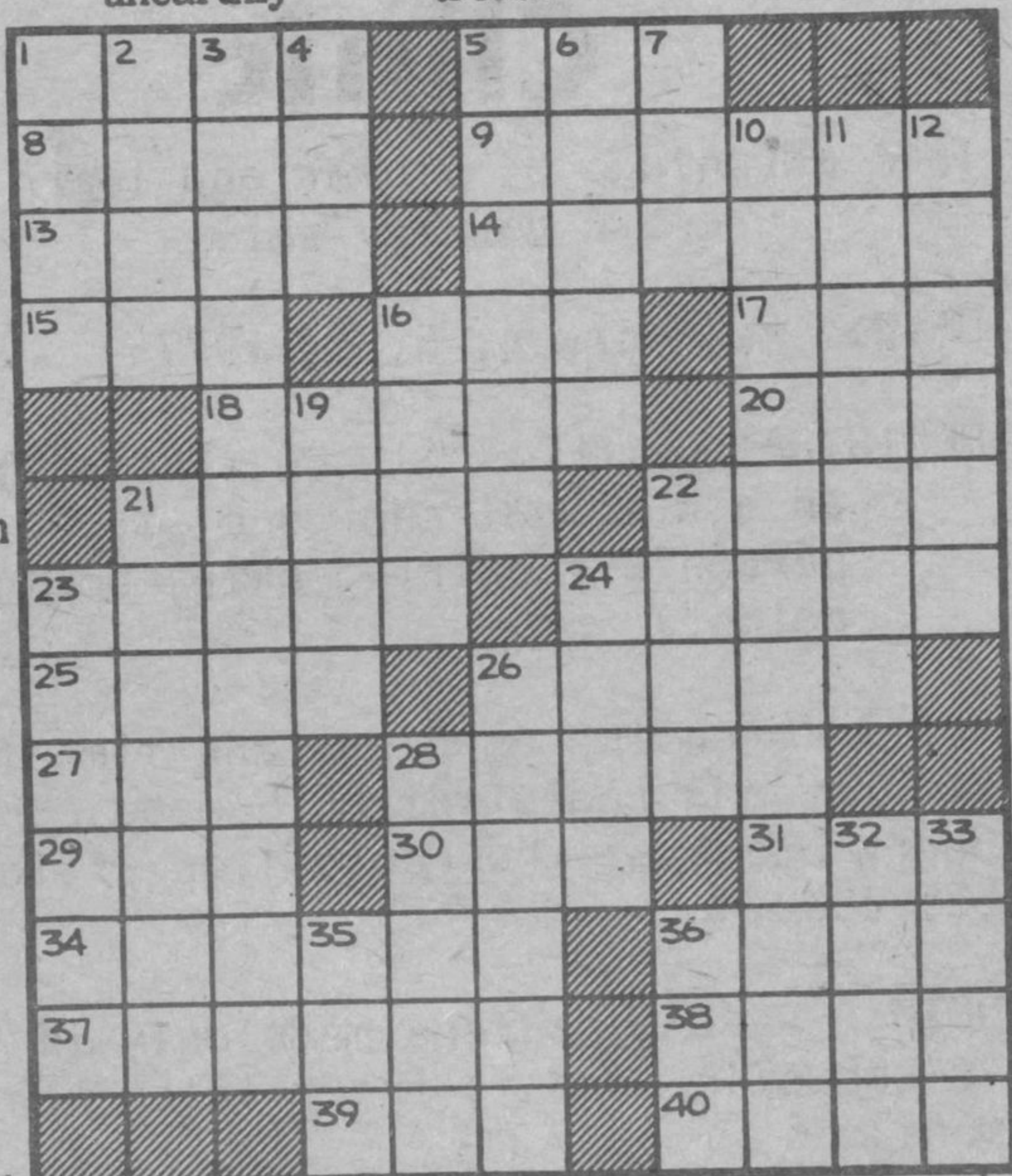

TERRACE BAY POLICE DEPARTMENT REPORT

The Terrace Bay Police Force was called upon to investigate twenty occurrences for the week January 17th to 23rd.

On January 18, as a result of a CB radio call, police attended an injury type accident on Highway 17 between Schreiber and Terrace Bay. A passenger was taken to hospital with a neck injury and the driver was charged with impaired driving. This investigation was turned over to the OPP.

On January 20th, members of the Terrace Bay Force checked a vehicle in the Townsite, and found the driver to be in possession of a narcotic. He was subsequently arrested and charged under the narcotics control act.

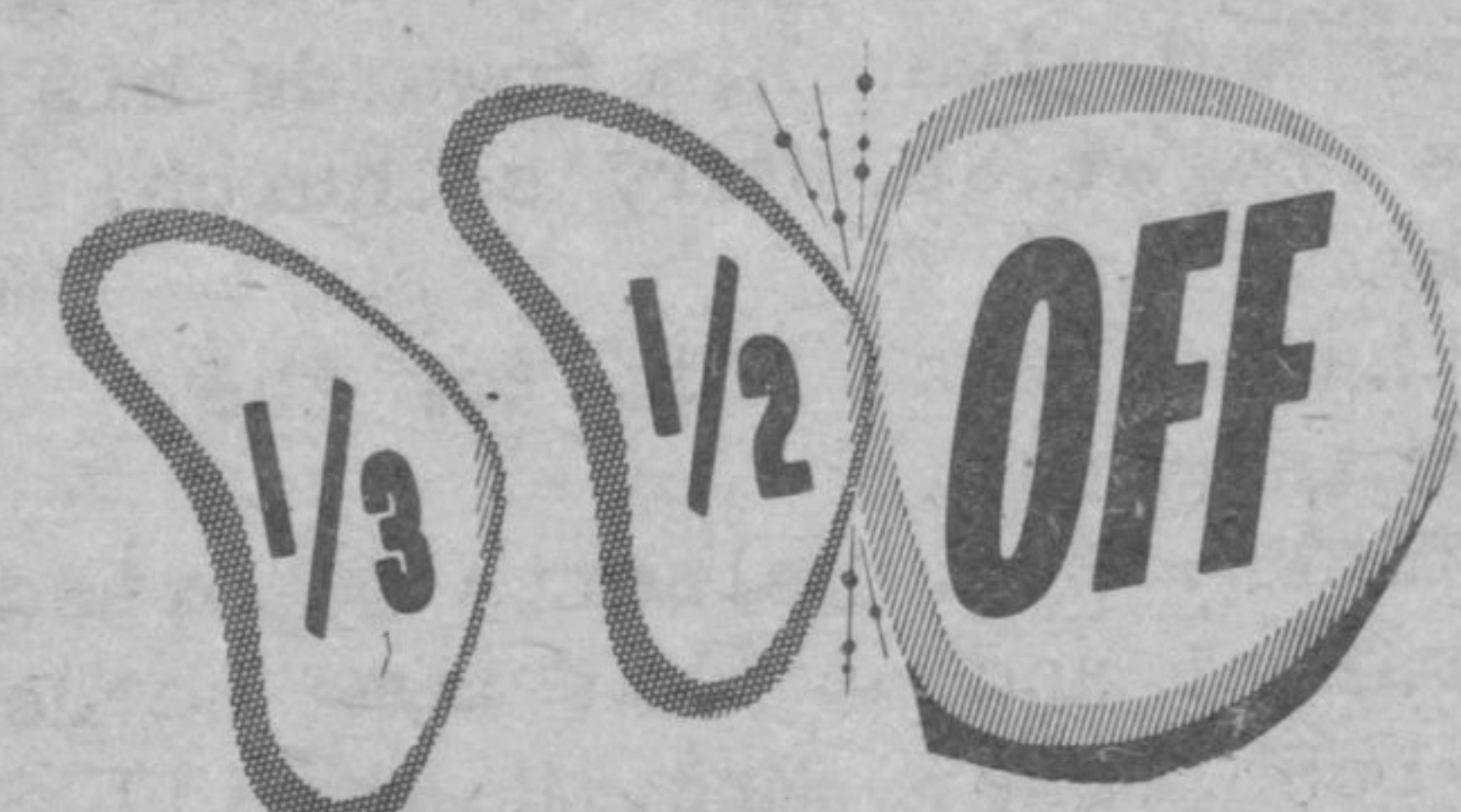
Two more fail to remain accidents were reported to police. Both accidents occurred in the Red Dog Inn parking lot and the drivers responsible failed to remain at the scene.
