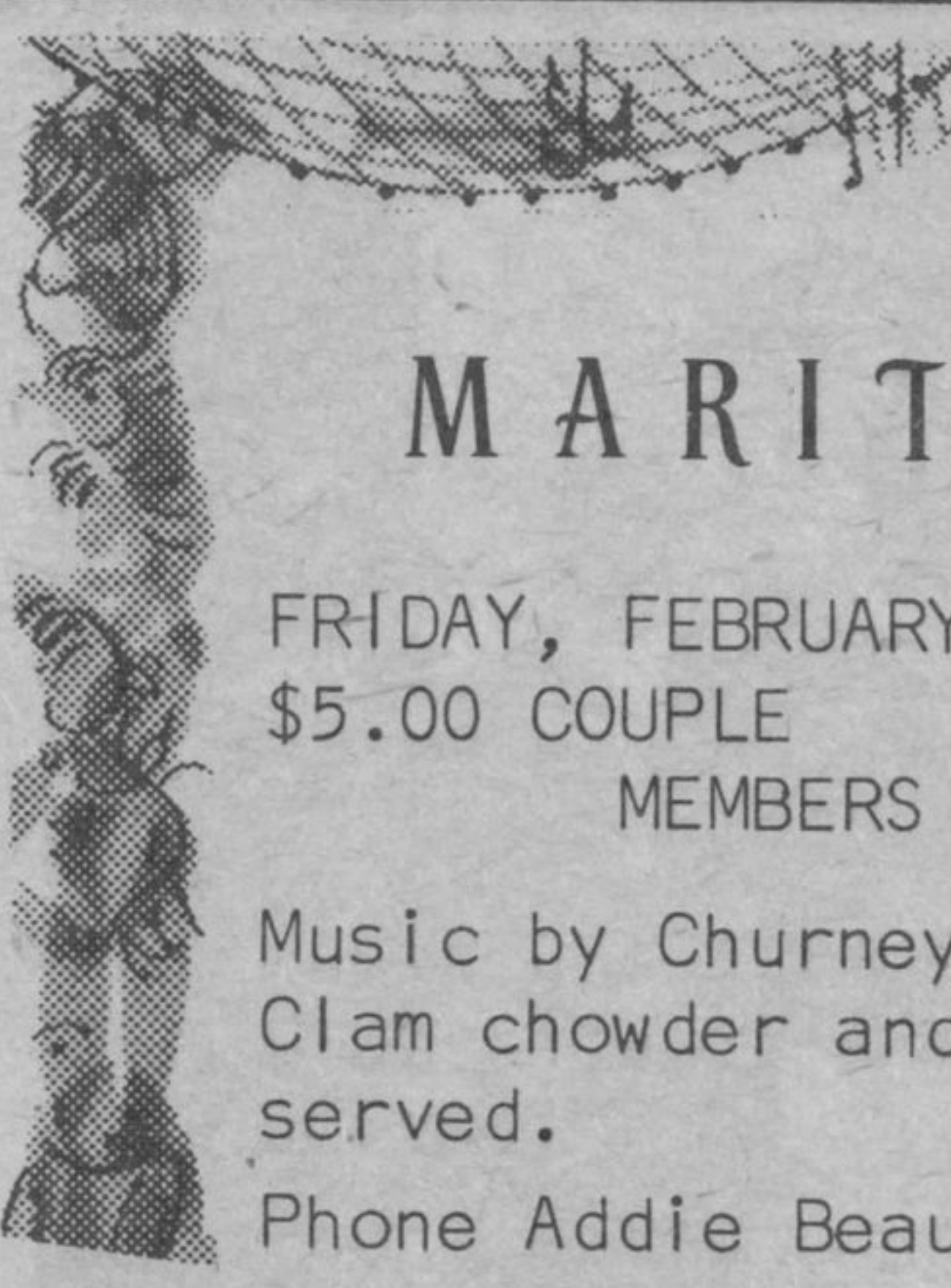
Peter Kovac, District #8 Commander ended the day with thanks to the Royal Canadian Legion Branch #223 for their very generous hospitality throughout the weekend.
