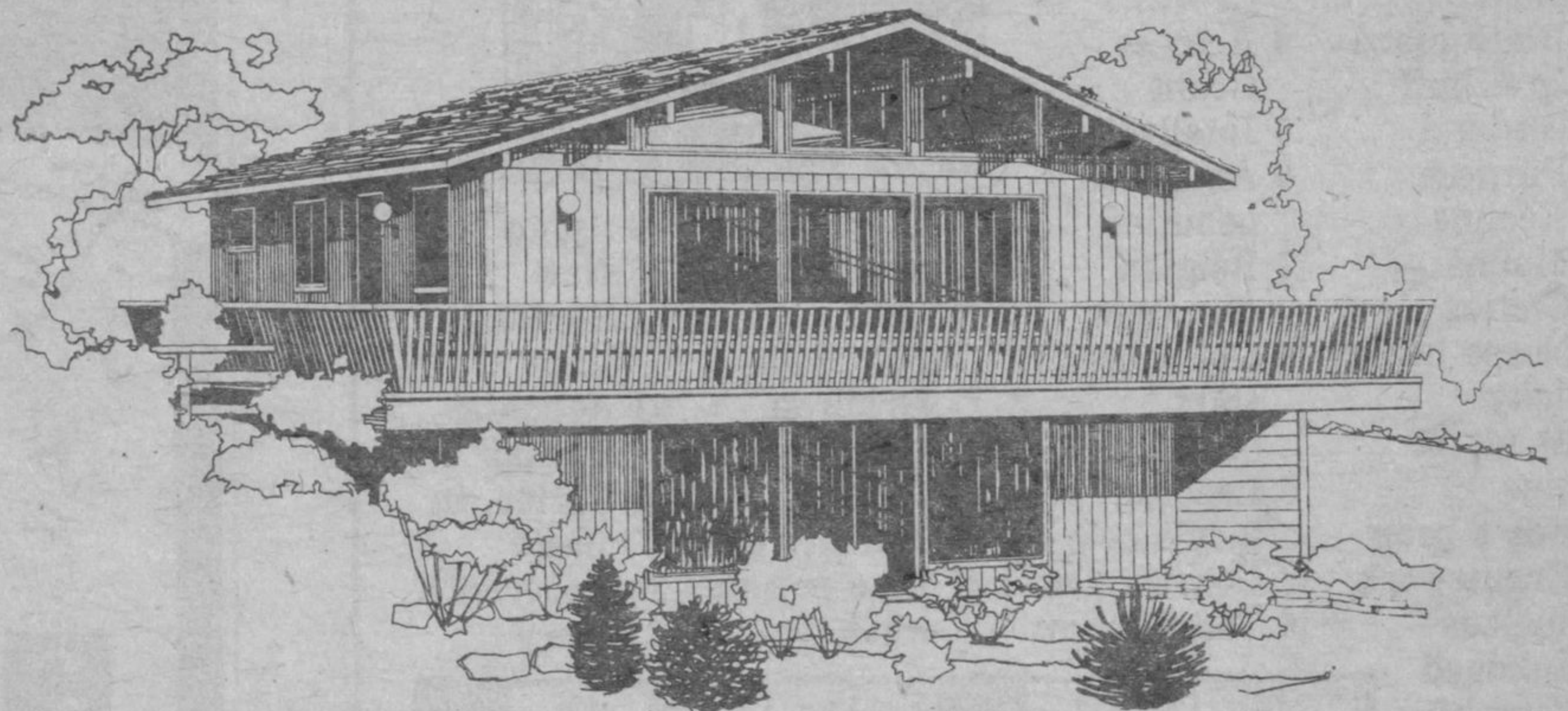

A city home with country flavor.

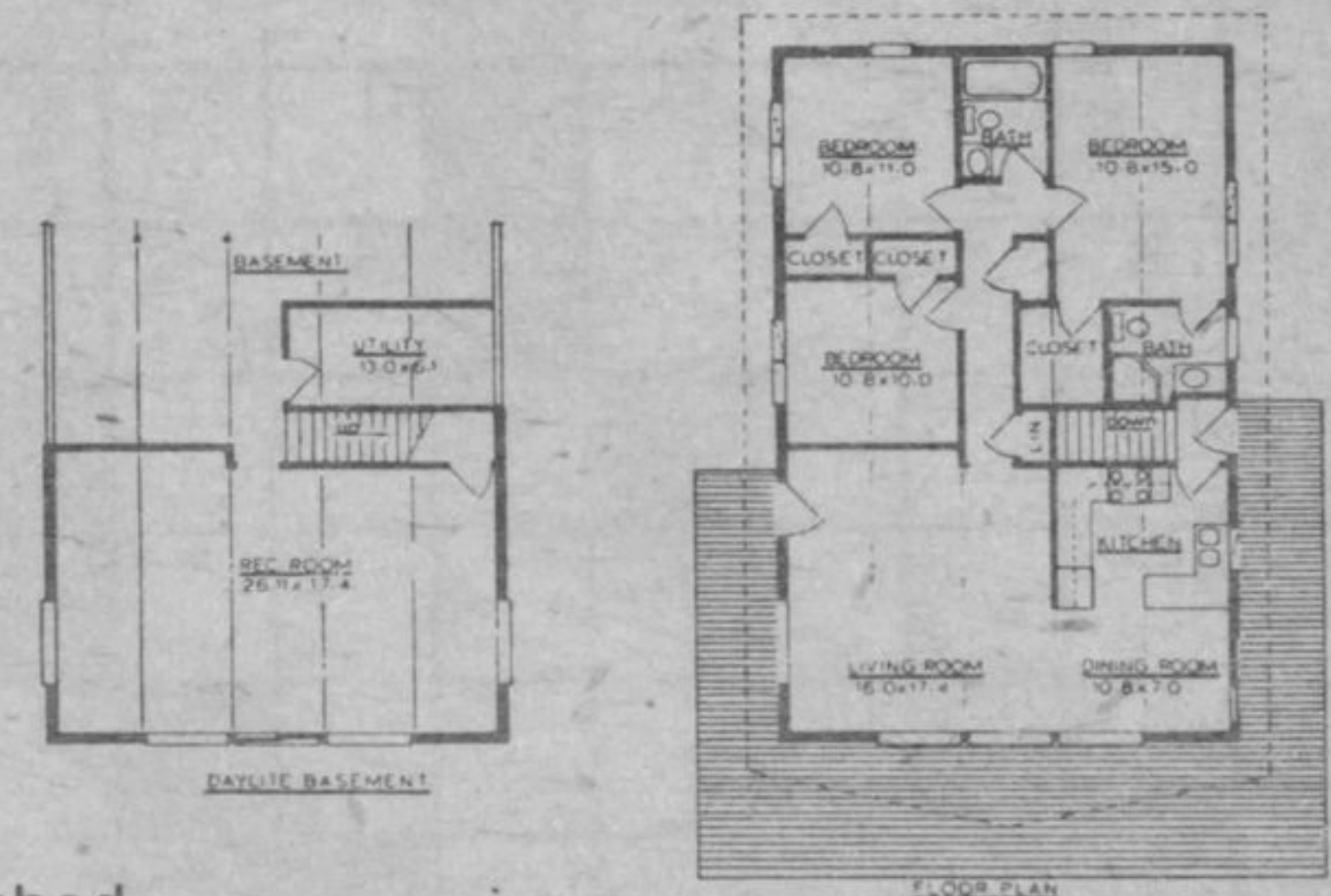


This 3-bedroom home makes the most of a narrow city lot, combining both natural "country" appeal and bonus space within just 27 ft. of width.
