The purpose of the meeting was to acquaint the villagers with different problem inves-

tigations for the unorganized communities. Special information was given that provides Government Services.

"Smoke Detectors Campaign" was discussed with many questions from the floor relevant to their operation, price to the members and how to display them in the home.

The Eye Clinic was thoroughly discussed and we were informed that this service is only offered during the summer months.

The possibility of a dental car being supplied to this area was questioned and information on same. It is impossible for a man with a large family to seek dental care otherwise.
