But if somebody in Schreiber or Terrace Bay wanted to call a telephone in Kenora or Thunder Bay they would simply dial 'l' plus the seven digits of the specific number because all four places are in the same area code (807).

"If you don't know the telephone number you wish to reach in some far-away place," Mr. Brisbin explained, "you dial 'l' to get you into the DDD network, then the area code of the community you want (if it is different from the one you are in), and finally dial 555-1212. A long distance directory assistance operator will answer and give you the telephone number you want. There is no charge for this service."

All subscribers in Schreiber and Terrace Bay will be getting a brochure in the mail which will give them instructions and details about Direct Distance Dialing.
