

SPEZIALE:

The death of the late Vincenzo Speziale, occurred in hospital on April 29th, 1977 after a brief illness.

His funeral was conducted on May 2nd, in Holy Angels Roman Catholic Church by Rev. Fr. Moore, assisted by Father Fularczuk of Terrace Bay and Father Oliverio of White River.

Prior to the church service the rosary was recited in the deceased's home in separate ceremonies by his family and the Catholic Women's League.

Speziale of Schreiber and six grandchildren.

Mr. Speziale, who was fifty-three years old, was born in Siderno Marina, Italy and came to Schreiber with his parents when he was fifteen years old.

He was employed with the Kimberly-Clark mill in Terrace Bay as a tradesman pipefitter. He was also a skilled carpenter, building his own home and at the time of his death building the home of his son, Ted. Each year his very productive vegetable garden was the envy of his immediate neighbours.
