This morning I was called to the office of our local Postmistress, Miss Barbara Haughn to be questioned as to the basis for my remarks to you about distribution of mail from this office. I was informed that Schreiber, Terrace Bay, Marathon, Manitouwadge and one or two other north shore communities maintain a "red bag" or mutual exchange of mail bags, once a day - a procedure which apparently is closely monitored by the offices involved.

Thus, any alleged delays in local mail delivery cannot be blamed on our post offices.

The Ontario Ministry of Agriculture publishes many brochures and fact sheets that will help the home gardener at this time of the year.

One of the fact sheets is "Compost & Composting" which explains this long recognized valuable soil additive. Composting is a tried and proven method of improving soil texture as well as fertilizing the soil and best of all you can produce the compost yourself.

Other fact sheets available include "Weed Killers for Lawns", "Sun Shy Garden Plants" and "Tree Wells and Retaining Walls".
