Supreme Lodge

The Supreme Lodge of the World, Loyal Order of Moose, which owns and operates Mooseheart, is headquartered in the two-story, brick building of colonial architecture which was erected in 1956. The building is located near the front entrance to the campus of the Child City.

Acreage

Mooseheart occupies 1,200 acres of fertile Fox River Valley land. Of this total, 313 acres are used for the campus, park and lake and the remainder for farming purposes.

Schools

Mooseheart provides total education from nursery school through the 12th grade. Mooseheart is a member of the North Central Association of Secondary Schools and Colleges and is supervised by the Department of Public Instruction of the State of Illinois.

Each student graduating from Mooseheart High School receives not only a diploma but a vocational education certificate. Each student is required to learn at least one trade and must complete all requirements before he is awarded the vocational certificate.

Sports Program

Mooseheart places much emphasis on sports. Red Rambler varsity football, basketball, track and wrestling teams are now competing in the Little Eight Conference.

In addition, the intramural program includes baseball, basketball, touch football, track, swimming and softball. Girls also compete in Conference archery, volleyball, swimming, track and bowling.

A standard physical education program for boys and girls is conducted in accordance with school regulations. The summer recreation program includes archery, tennis and boating in addition to many of the sports listed above.
