A store for boys and a store for girls is maintained at Mooseheart. The students do not wear uniforms, but go to their respective stores and select their clothing from the racks and shelves. They are provided requisitions for apparel by their housemothers whenever they need new items.

In addition, a shoe store for boys and a shoe store for girls is operated. A trained shoeman has the responsibility of making sure the Mooseheart youngsters are well shoed. A repair shop keeps the shoes in good condition.
