

SCHREIBER HYDRO ELECTRIC COMMISSION CORRECTION ON RATE CARDS

Third Block should be 2.3 and not 3.8 as stated.

Using a figure of 3000 KW consumption on a two (2) month billing at the old rate customers bill would total \$63.30.

Using the same 3000 KW consumption at new rate a customers bill would be \$80.20 - a difference of \$16.90 or \$8.45 per month increase.
