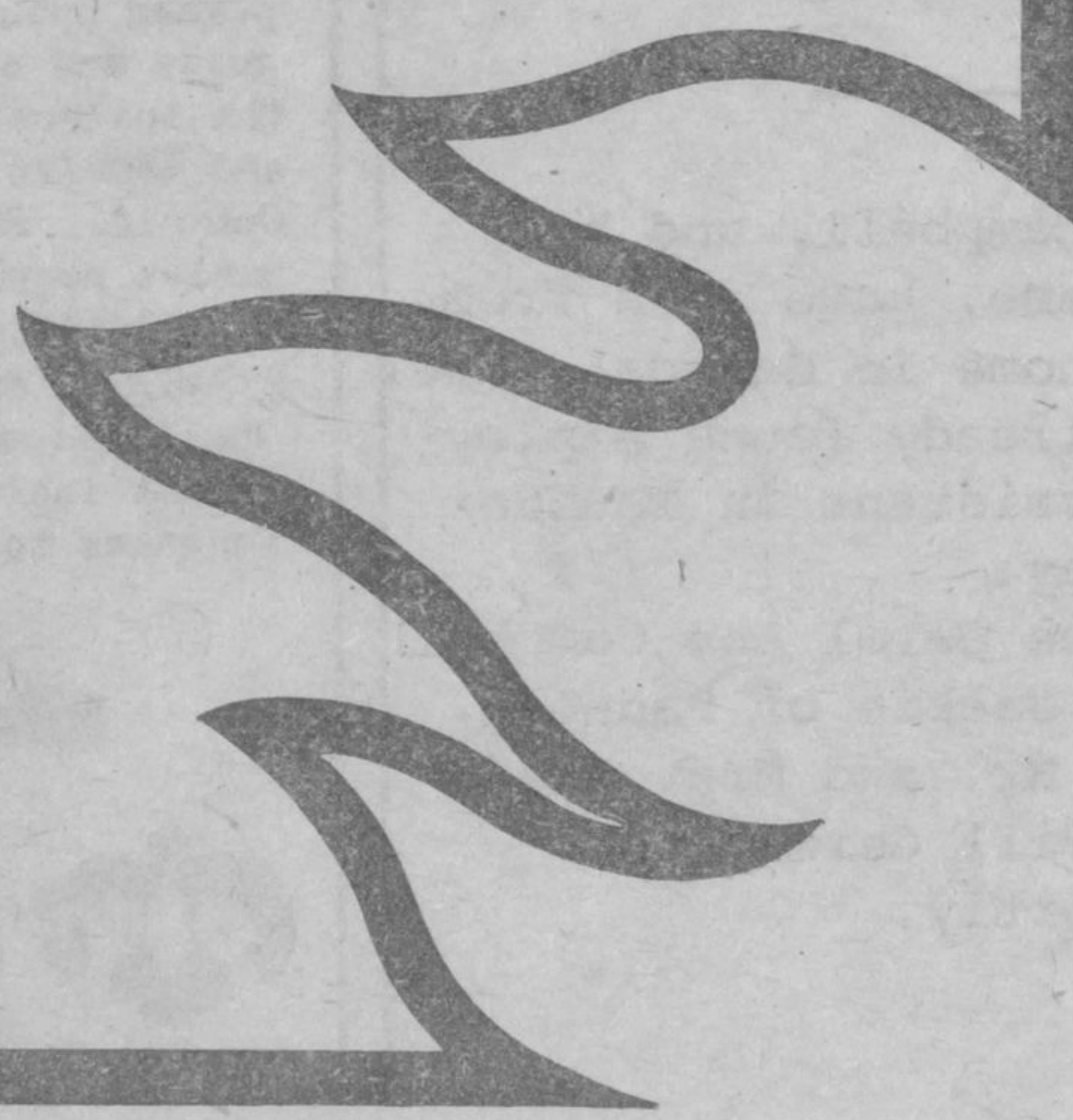
Ratings: Six correct — you sure know your stuff
