In earlier years, Mrs. McCoshen had been interested in painting; a member of the first Art Club in Schreiber and later delighted in travelling.


She was always "Molly" to her many old friends in Schreiber and remembered for her Irish wit and expressions which were immediate -ly adopted and still used.
