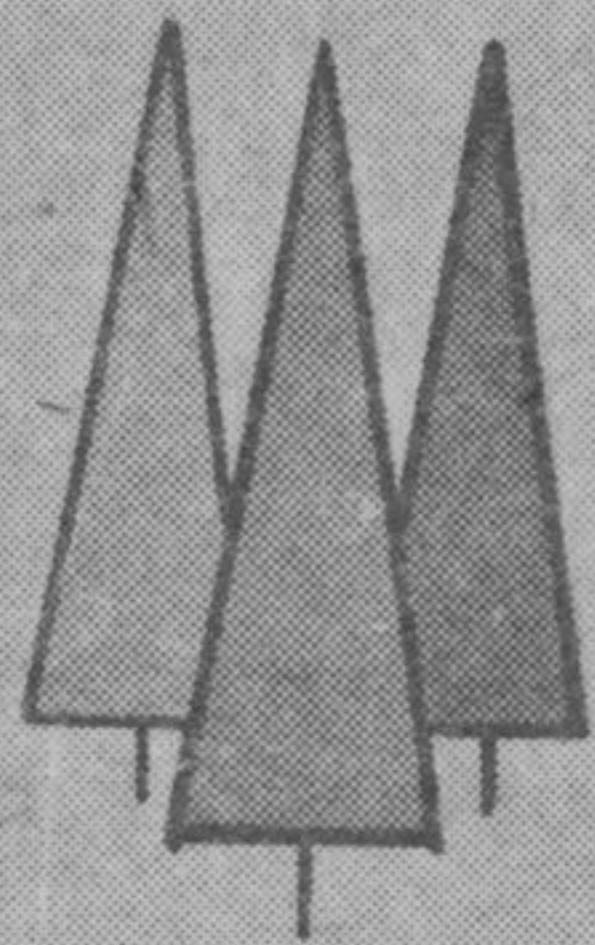
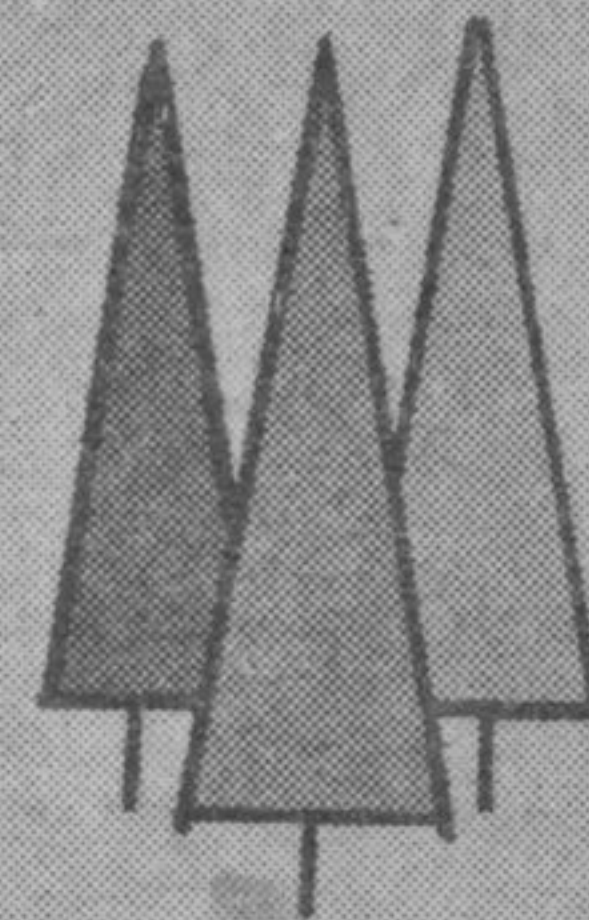

LAKEHEAD SHRINE CLUB CARAVAN TO TERRACE BAY

On Saturday, August 13th, 1977, the Lakehead Shrine Club of Khartum Temple, Winnipeg, will be in Terrace Bay for the purpose of presenting a piece of special equipment to the Children's Ward of the McCausland Hospital.

The Shriners of America have accepted the sponsoring and financial operating of nineteen Shriners Hospitals for Crippled Children and three Shriners Burns Hospitals in North America and Hawaii. Since organizing in 1922 the Hospitals have treated in excess of 183,000 children for Orthopedic and Burns disabilities.

In addition to operating the Crippled Children and Burns Hospitals the Shriners donate necessary equipment to Childrens' Wards in local and district Hospitals.

A number of the Units of the Lakehead Shrine Club will be attending the presentation and will parade in front of the Shopping area at approximately 1:30 p.m., prior to the presentation at the Hospital.
