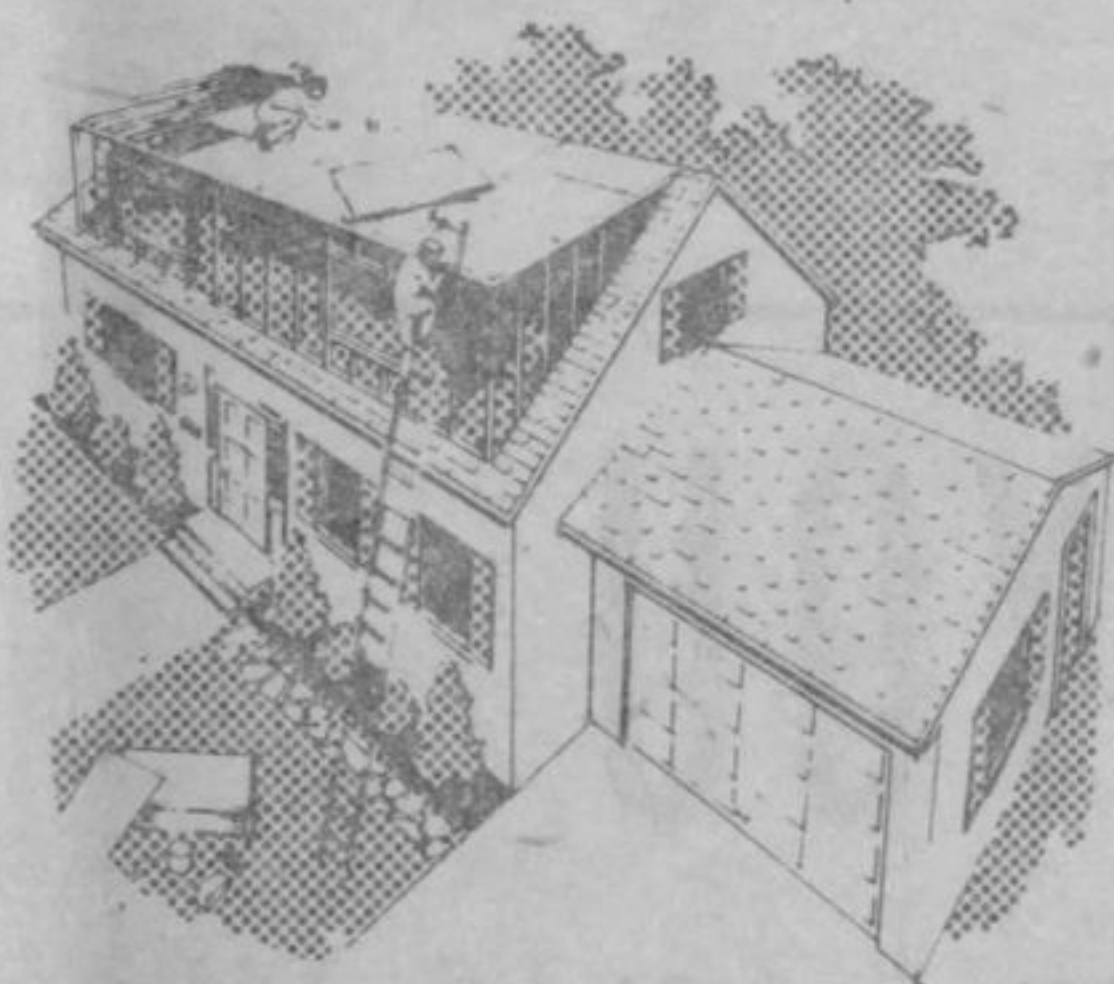
The public is advised, that the disposal area east of the Kimberly-Clark Mill known as the lime dump is closed to public use.
