The angling season in Killala Lake has been shortened since the lake has become a major producer of lake trout spawn for the Provincial hatchery system.

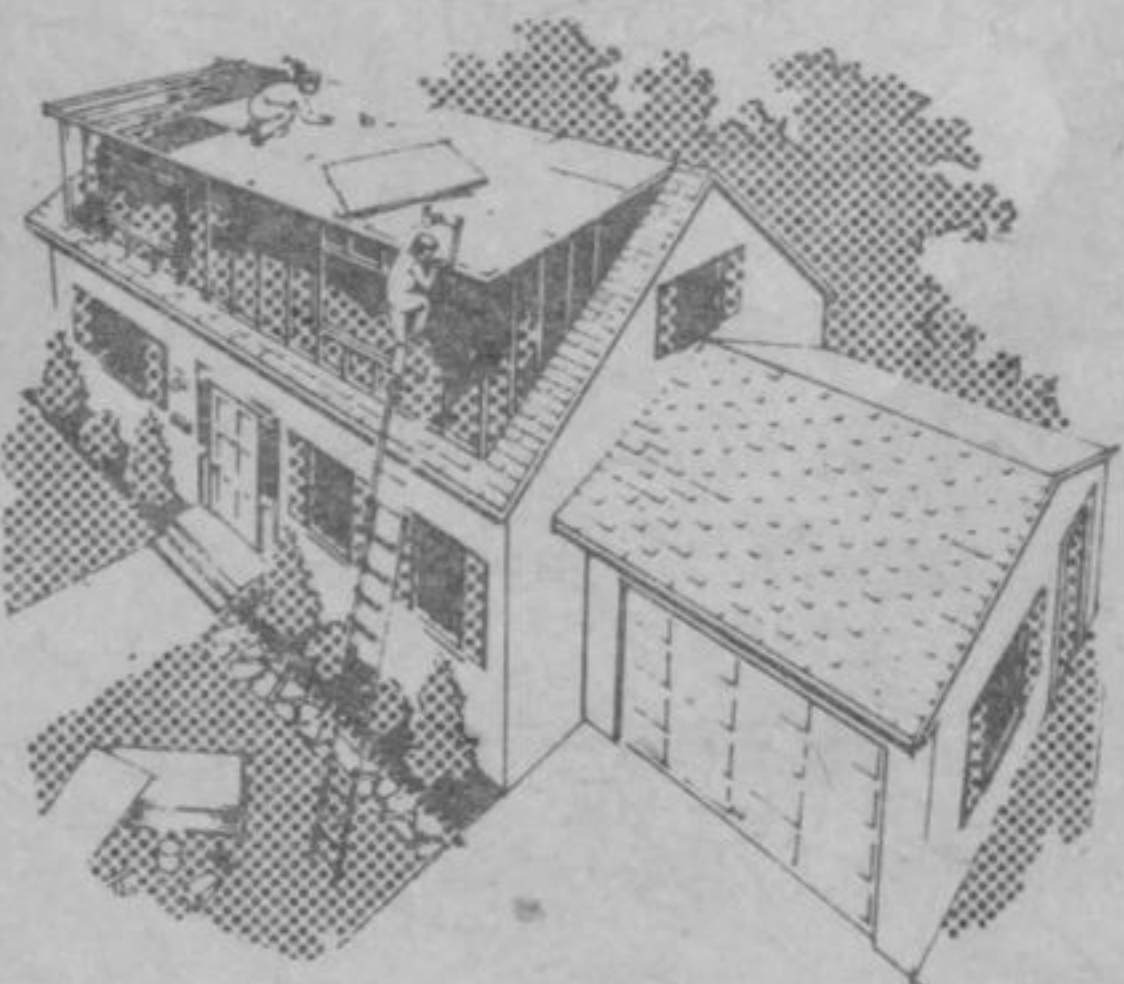
