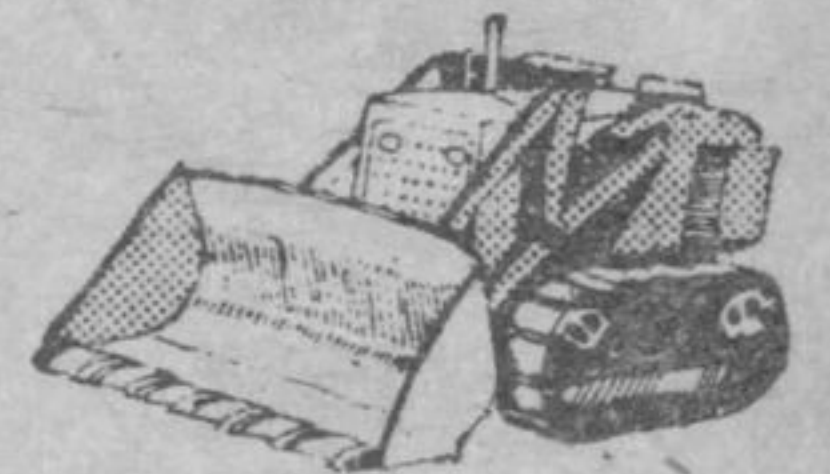
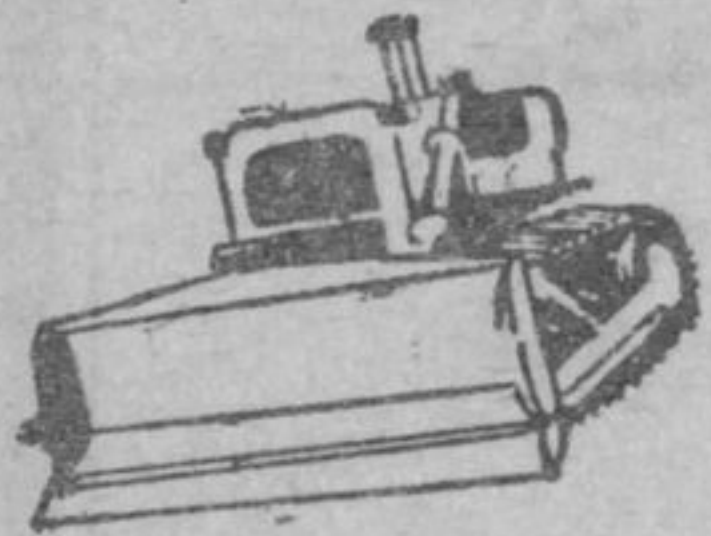
INTERMEDIATE HOCKEY LEAGUE

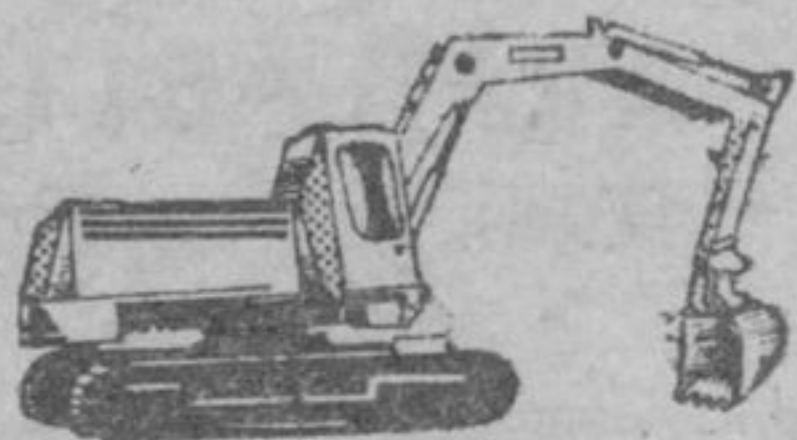
follows: President - Rod MacKenzie; Vice-President - Len Smith; Treasurer - Ken Turner; Secretary - John McGrath.

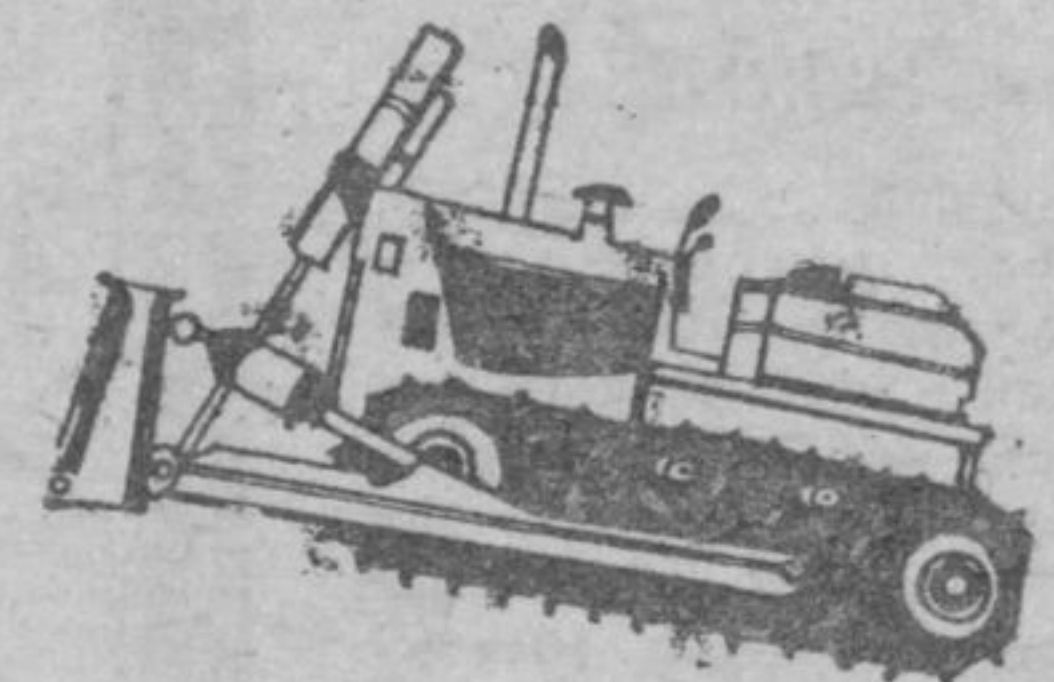
