Poems on Thanksgiving were read by Mrs. Winnie Campbell, Margaret Spillane and Winnie Clemens.


There will be a speaker at the November meeting.

Following the meeting, penny auction was played and a cold plate supper enjoyed.


L.A. ROYAL CANADIAN LEGION BR. 109:






