The employee was not hurt. However, he wasted no time in getting back into the building to take cover.

Numerous bullet holes were found in the walls of the front porch of the building located at the base of the tower.

Bell employees work at this tower not only in the daytime, but, some evenings and nights as well.

If the shootings continue there is the grim possibility of someone being seriously injured or killed.
