RE: PERMITS FOR THE INSTALLATION AND ALTERATION OF HEATING SYSTEMS.

Schreiber residents are reminded that By-Law 605, Section 4.11 (Building Permit By-Law) requires that a permit be obtained before the installation of a heating system, or new boiler, or furnace is installed in a residence.

The Ontario Building Code, which is in effect in all parts of the Province provides for minimum clearances on installation of furnaces both solid fuel burning, and oil.

Any person who is installing a new heating system of any kind, and who is concerned regarding the correct clearances to be maintained, should contact the Schreiber Fire Brigade, P. Doig, Chief, for further information.
