STRATEGIC LAND USE PLAN FOR NORTHWESTERN ONTARIO

The Ministry of Natural Resources' SLUP
Phase II report for Northwestern Ontario is
still available for public discussion. The
Phase II report "Proposed Policy" was released
in September of 1977 in an effort to stimulate
discussion of the policy objectives to be utilized by the Ministry in the preparation of
the Strategic Land Use Plan. The report is
the culmination of an extensive policy review
within the Northwestern Region by both the Min
-istry of Natural Resources and the general
public, and presents the candidate policies as
revised from the original document "Background
Information and Approach to Policy" which was
widely circulated in 1974 and 1975.

In an effort to obtain additional public input, the deadline for responding to the policy objectives has been extended to January 31, 1978. Continued page 3
