Happy, sunny-tempered, lovable Aaron welcomes attention but does not demand it. He is very active and talkative, speaking so far in single words. He appears bright and alert but there is a

suggestion he may have learning disabilities later on.

Aaron needs a mother and father who will not be so fearful of his condition that they will be over-protective. They should be able to help him towards as normal a life as possible while being ready to cope with the injuries that are bound to occur.


