

## COUNCIL HIRES RECREATION CO-ORDINATOR

The regular meeting of the Council of the Township of Terrace Bay was held in the Council Chambers, Monday, January 23, 1978, at 7 P.M. Present were Reeve C. Brassard, Councillors M. Hamilton, G. Ramsay and P. Romanuk, Clerk Co-ordinator W. Hanley and M. Simmer.

Minutes of the regular meeting January 9th were adopted as read.

The following accounts were approved for payment: Township - \$44,650.80, Hydro - \$4,710.81, Library - \$381.84, Recreation - \$11,086.70.

The resignation of Rhea Beaulieu as Meter Reader was accepted with regret.

J. Hale and T. Costa were appointed as members of the Planning Committee and J. Hale as a member of the Committee of Adjustment.

An interim tax bill will be issued on all taxable assessment on a mill rate of 10 mills - effective date of payment to be March 24th, 1978.

Mr. Barclay Mayhew has been hired as a Recreation Co-ordinator effective February 27, 1978. The usual six months probationary period will apply.

W.L. Wardrop and Associates will be engaged to prepare final design of 3200 foot airstrip.

One building permit in the amount of \$39,600.00 was issued in the past month.
