- Q. I took an early retirement this year when I turned 58. Can I claim a deduction for my pension income, or do I have to wait until I'm 65?
- A. Yes, regardless of age you may claim a deduction for the pension you receive up to a maximum of \$1000.00. This deduction does not apply to CPP and QPP benefits or the Old Age Pension.
