Creation of the park provides an opportunity to preserve a portion of landscape in which some plants and animals are unique and have complex ecological relationships as well as providing a high quality wilderness environment for public use.

Pukaskwa National Park, with an area of 1,876 kilometers (725 square miles), is an example of the central boreal uplands rugged terrain broken by sharp slopes and depressions covered with shallow soil.

The short, swift rivers in the park run down to the coast of Lake Superior where thousands of years of wave action have worn the rocky granite shore smooth.

The name Pukaskwa is derived from Ojibwa words 'Pkajawe' or 'Puhkahzhuhwa' which refer to cleaning of fish.

Theme for the park is 'The Wild Shore of an Inland Sea', combining the two major elements of Pukaskwa, interior wilderness and Lake Superior coastline.

TAX TIPS

Q. I filed my income tax return a week ago, but yesterday I received another T4 slip I had forgotten about. What should I do?

A. Write to the Taxation Data Centre serving your region and attach a copy of the T4 slip. Above all, do not file another return for this late T4 slip or for any other information slip you have received since filing your return. Please include your Social Insurance Number or your Account Number with your name and address.
