**WACOUSTA:**

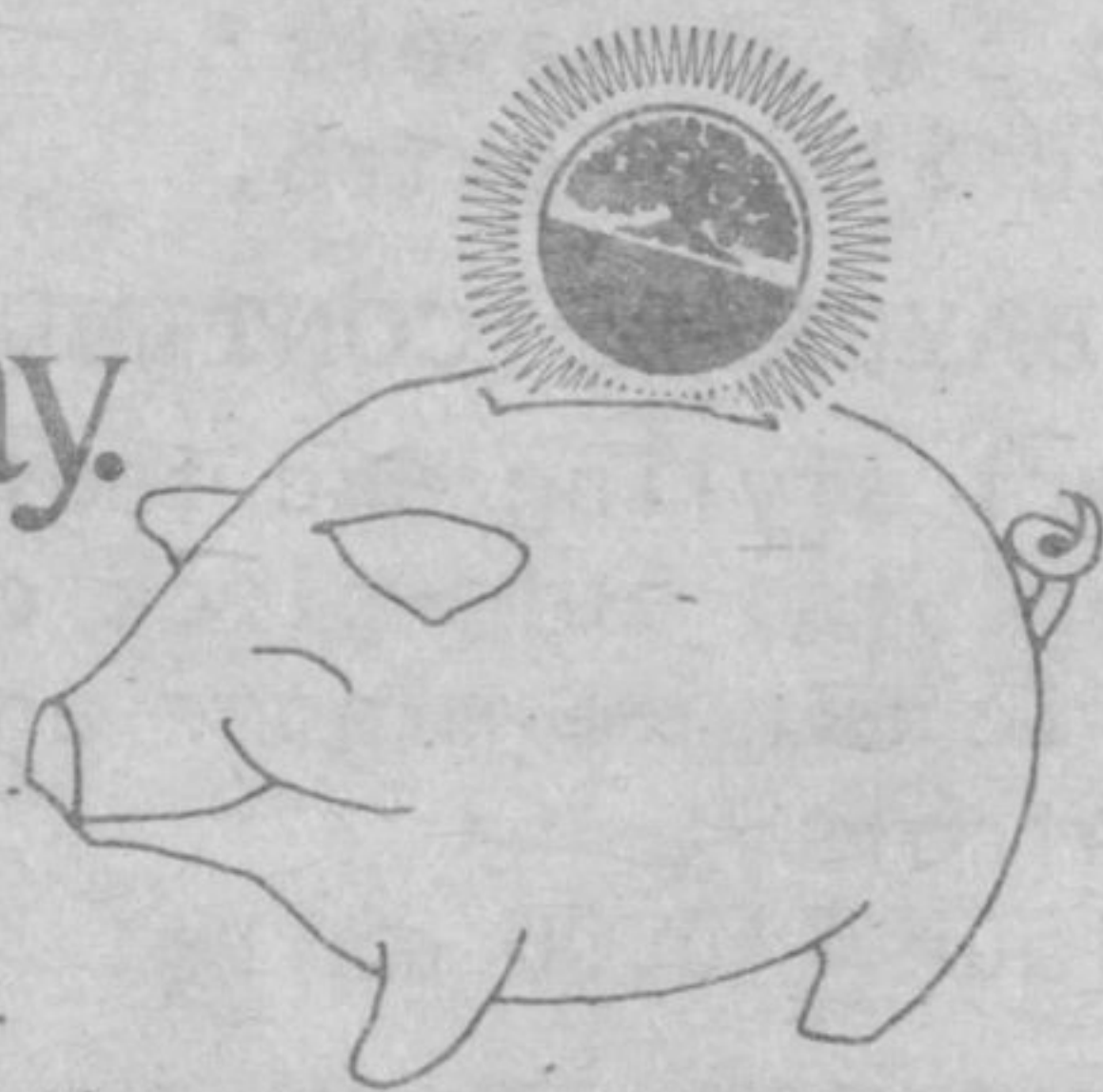
