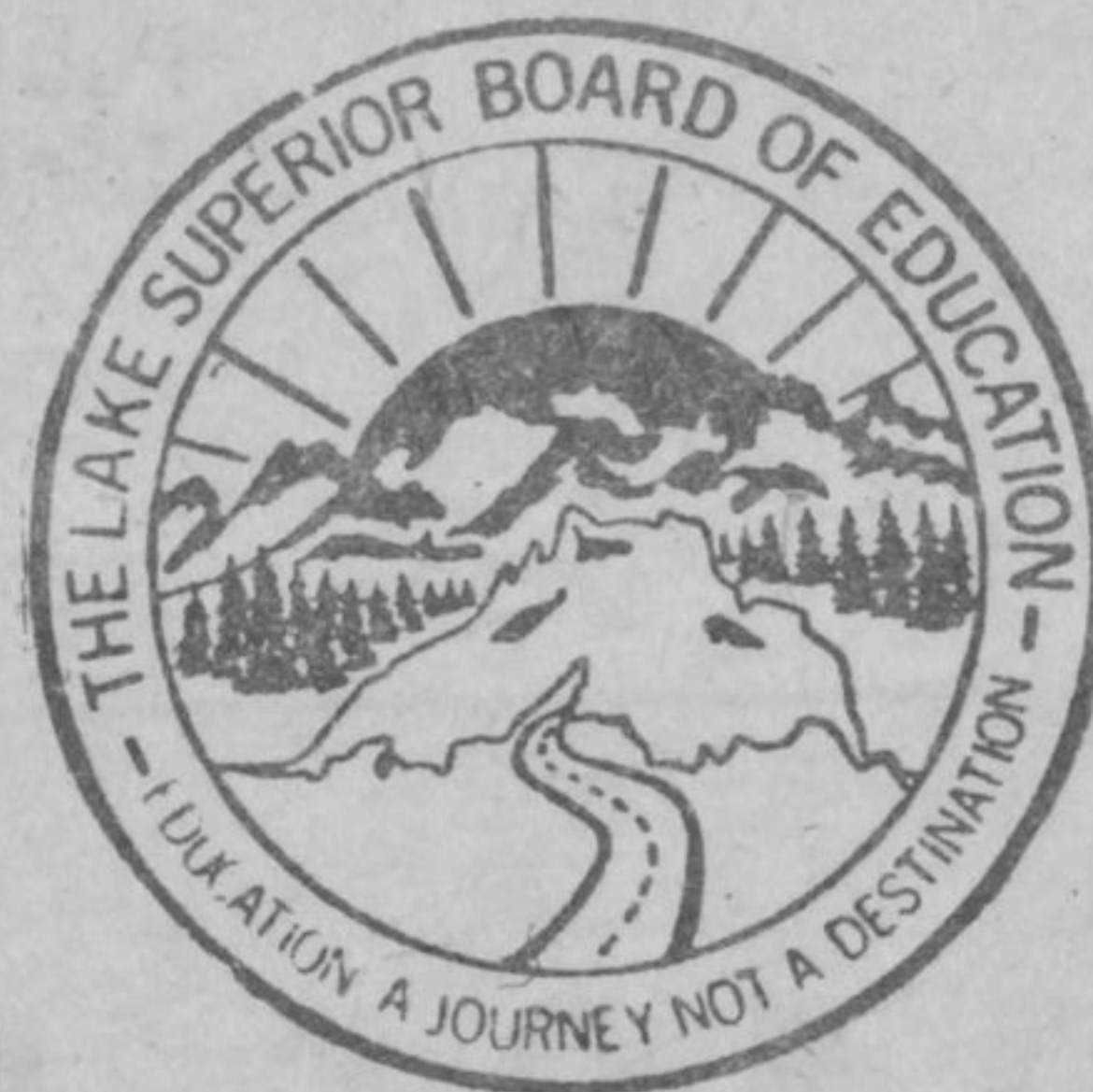

# 1978

## BUDGET

At a special meeting held 1978 03 14, The Lake Superior Board of Education approved its budget for 1978 involving a total spending of approximately \$4.7 million; \$2.1 million for Elementary schools - \$2.6 million for Secondary schools. Of the total, approximately 71% will go toward salaries and fringe benefits, 15% to supplies and services, 8% to capital equipment and debt charges, 4% to contractual services and 2% to miscellaneous expenses. Approximately \$2.5 million of the total expenditures will be recovered through provincial grants for 1978, while various other revenues should offset another \$230,000 in expenditures. The balance of the budget will be financed through taxes levied in the eight communities served by the Board. The net result of the 1978 budget is an approximate 4.4% increase in educational taxes for the average tax payer supporting public schools, throughout the school division.
