The 1978 Road Maintenance and Construction program for sub sidizable roads in the amount of \$39,000.00 was adopted.

The Cancer Society was given permission to canvas the town.

An inquiry re a playground area in lot 276 Kenogami Road

has been referred to the Recreation Committee.

Council agreed to revising their previous resolution re the airport and include the development of a new access road from Hwy 17, left turn lane, taxiway, aircraft parking area, public parking area, electrical supply, terminal building, meteorological equipment, unicom radio, 4,000 ft. runway including lighting. The estimated cost to be \$500,000.00. Council requests the Ministry of Transportation and Communications subsidy of 80% of the cost of all items except that portion of the runway exceeding 3,500 ft. on which subsidy will be 50%. Council will accept the balance of the capital cost and is requesting approval for the project year 1978.
