

ORIGINS OF NAMES

Miss Judy Kuromoto of the Department of Natural Resources, Scarborough, Ontario, was in the village of Rosspport recently, seeking information re the naming of small inland lakes and streams north of Rosspport and lakes on the islands in the bay. At one time these numerous lakes did not have a name unless some local guide or man in the area tacked on some sort of identification. Finally the Conservation Club in the 1940's undertook the naming of the dozens of lakes. This organization is now known as the Game and Fish Association.

Among some of the streams and lakes given names are -- Ault Lake and creek after our first chief Fire Ranger situated at Pays Plat siding; Todesco Lake after the Rosspport merchant Charles Todesco; Josephine and the Kenney Lakes after Mr. and Mrs. Ray Kenney; Hewitson River after an early school teacher - J.F. Hewitson; Hiller lake after a commercial fisherman Ted Hiller; Cathy Lake after the wife of Indian Chief Jerry Bouchard of the mission; Dan's Lake after Daniel Gerow; Bear Trap Lake because it resembles the shape of a bear trap; Harry's Lake after Harry Tympko a storekeeper; Eli's Lake after Eli King a fisherman; Lesarge Lake after a fisherman; Jim's Lake after Jimmy Paulmert a fisherman and Sky Lake because it is at the top of a high hill.

HALF-LOADING REGULATIONS will go into effect in District 19, Thunder Bay

AT: 12:01 A.M., FRIDAY, MARCH 24, 1978
(Unless Otherwise Notified)

on ALL HIGHWAYS and SECONDARY ROADS EXCEPT THE FOLLOWING:

- (1) All of Highway 11
- (2) All of Highway 11B
- (3) All of Highway 17
- (4) All of Highway 61
- (5) All of Highway 102
- (6) Highway 130 - from the Junction of Highway 11/17 Southerly for 8.4 km
- (7) Highway 527 (Formerly Highway 800) - from Armstrong Southerly for 24.0 km
- (8) Highway 584 - from Highway 11 - to the South Limit of the Geraldton Connecting Link
- (9) Highway 588 - from the Junction of Highway 11/17 Southerly for 1.6 km
- (10) Highway 589 - from the Junction of Highway 102 - to the Junction of Highway 591
- (11) Highway 590 - from the Junction of Highway 11/17 Westerly for 2.0 km
- (12) Highway 599 - from Savant Lake CNR Crossing Northerly - to the Junction of Highway 646
- (13) Highway 608 - from Highway 61 Westerly 1.0 km
- (14) All of Highway 623
- (15) All of Highway 628
- (16) All of Highway 646
- (17) Highway 808 - from the Junction of Highway 599 Northerly for 3.5 km

HALF-LOADING REGULATIONS will also go into effect on Local Roads in the FOLLOWING LOCAL ROADS BOARDS AREAS:

Dawson Road - Goldie, Forbes, Fowler, Gorham, Inwood, Jacques, Stirling, Upsals, and Ware.

During Half-Loading Season, no Special Permits for overloading or house moving will be issued on any Highway, or in any of the local Roads Boards Areas, in this District.
