F8 and F9 are Multipurpose rooms with special arrangements in the entrance area should the room be needed for isolation (where nurses and doctors can change into sterile garments and dispose of them afterwards, etc.)

F10 and F11 - single bed rooms; F12 - 2 bed rooms; F13 - 4 bed rooms; F14 - 1 bed room.
