A letter from the Township of Schreiber was received stating that Mrs. Dorothy Rummery has been reappointed as Council Representative to the McCausland Hospital Board.

A letter from the Deputy Minister of the Ministry of Health, stated that the Hospital is still under the A.I.B. guidelines to the end of 1978.

Roland Wills submitted his resignation to the Board as he will assume the duties of Resident Inspector of the Hospital Construction - reporting to the Board.

The Chairman stated that the Development Committee will be dissolved at the Annual Meeting, but the Core Committee will continue to function.
