# NOTICE TO REALTY TAXPAYERS

The Council of the Township of Terrace Bay has authorized the establishment of a system of municipal and school tax credits and refunds under the provisions of The Municipal and School Tax Credit Assistance Act, R.S.O. 1970 to assist elderly persons. A tax credit equivalent to one-half of the municipal and school taxes may be allowed in respect of a real property, subject to a maximum of \$150.00 if:

- a) the owner, and/or the husband or the wife of the owner, is 65 years of age or more and occupies the real property as a personal residence.
- b) application is made by the taxpayer during the calendar year in which the realty taxes, in respect of which the tax credit is claimed, become due and payable, and
- The ramaining portion of the realty taxes, after the deduction of the tax credit, has been paid.
- d) applicants will be required to produce documents of title when applying for a tax credit.
