FROM THE RECORDS: It was just two years ago this week that the first house was erected at Terrace Bay, and around the Millsite, clearing gangs were busy removing tree stumps prior to the commencement of construction work in that area. The tank for the Lower Camp water tower had arrived and only 170 men were at work on the entire project. Last year about this time the new dual purpose cafeteria-recreation building was used for the first time as a moving picture show. Around the ball field, Comets and Hydro were setting the pace. At the Millsite, progress was made as concrete foundations were being poured, one of the largest being 336 cubic yard pour for the Drum Barker foundation.
