

COUNCIL QUOTES

TERRACE BAY

The regular meeting of the Council of the Township of Terrace Bay was held on August 14th.

Minutes of the previous meeting were adopted as presented. The following accounts were approved for payment:

Township - \$114,386.39

Hydro:- \$26,798.46 Library - \$2,094.07

Recreation - \$28,322.47

R.T. Yates will tender for garbage collection in the amount of \$1,775.00 per month. This contract is to extend from September 1, 1978 until August 31, 1980.

Public works will assume the responsibility of reading the meters effective September, 1978.

Stephen Zysco Construction Ltd. will tender for the construction of the municipal airport for the amount of \$542,427.50, subject to the signing of an agreement between the Township of Terrace Bay and the Province of Ontario represented by the Ministry of Transport. This contract should be awarded upon provincial approval. The airport is to be completed by November, 1978.

SCHREIBER

Schreiber Council are hoping to start water and sewer lines on Peary and Langworthy Streets this week and are only waiting for final Ministry of the Environment consent. The material is on hand and money for this project was given through the Ministry of Northern Affairs in the amount of \$106,000.00.

It is also the intention of Council to proceed with water and sewer on Langworthy west of Peary having set aside some monies for this in the budget.

Council also have approval from MTC for Storm Sewers on Bayview and Winnipeg extension for \$40,000 subsidy. Clear title to the roads from Marathon Realty is required before this subsidy will be paid. The total cost of the project will be just over \$100,000.00 counting Engineering fees.

Anyone who would be willing to serve on the Cemetery Board are asked to give their name to the Clerk.

A program to repair some of the sidewalks in town has started with as much as possible being done this year.

Mr. Reg Yates has been given the contract to pick up the Township garbage while the Municipalities of Scheriber and Terrace Bay will jointly look after the Landfill Site.

Latest work on the Senior Citizens Apartments is that construction will start about the middle of September.
