By sponsoring clinics of this nature, the O.C.A. hopes to generate more enthusiasm for the fine sport of cycling in Northern Ontario and to teach proper riding techniques and mechanical repairs.

Bob Zeller of the O.C.A., during the four clinics, instructed the sixty participants in the mechanics of bicycles, adjustments and preparation, basic riding, touring techniques and safety measures. A short, informal bike tour of Schreiber gave participants a taste of touring.

Though highway 17 has few paved shoulders and the traffic can be thick and fast, the course teaches cyclists to ride out one meter from the shoulder, thereby forcing motorists to pass properly, rather than squeezing through a gap. Also, the fantastic scenery of the area more than compensates for this disadvantage.

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
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
