Funeral Services for the late A.B. "Muggs" McCuaig, whose death occurred in Thunder Bay on September 16th, were held in St. Andrew's United Church, Schreiber, on September 19, 1978. Rev. "Muggs" who was 87 years of age, was born in Campbells Bay, Quebec, he came to Schreiber in 1906, and in 1908 he was employed by the C.P.R. retiring in 1965 as a Conductor, after 48 years of service. 
