Council will purchase two Overture Concert tickets for one male and one female senior citizen for the 1978-79 season.

R.T. Yates has been engaged to haul granular material for the landfill site. The Reeve and Clerk Co-ordinator were authorized to sign a land use permit for the site.

B. Thorenstein has been appointed as a by-law officer for the purpose of enforcing local by-laws respecting garbage collection, disposal and littering for the Township of Terrace Bay.

The hospital reports that Great Lakes Steel is working at the site and construction is on schedule.

Council will send a request to the Ministry of Housing for financial aid in order to conduct a Special Study of the down-town commercial development and potential for the Township of Terrace Bay. The purpose of this study is to determine how the area can best be utilized with a view to maintaining a central commercial area. An estimate of the cost of the study is \$10,000.00 to \$12,000.00.
