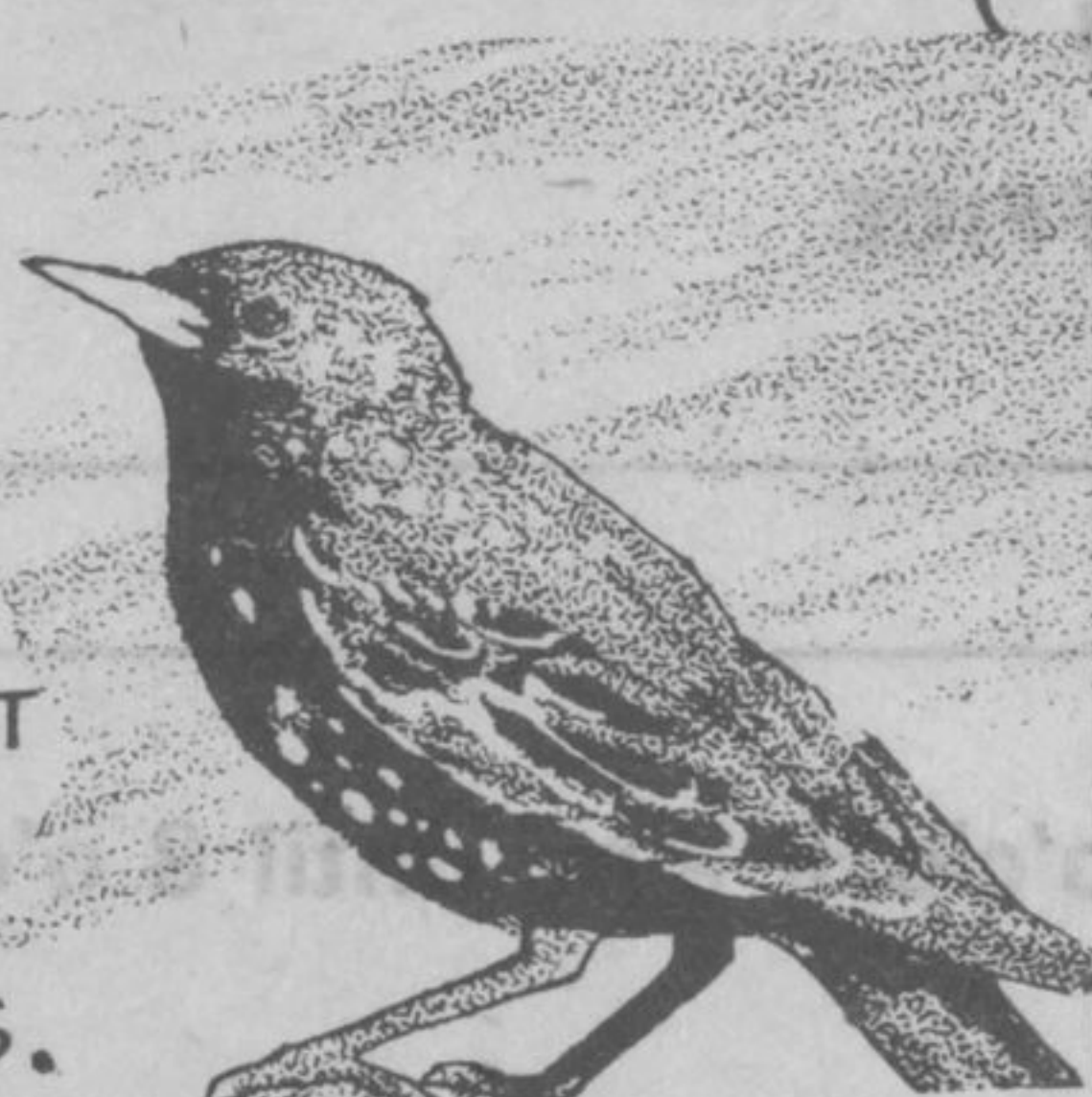

A two thousand dollar grant is expected for repair and improvements of the dock street road. Questions were asked re-

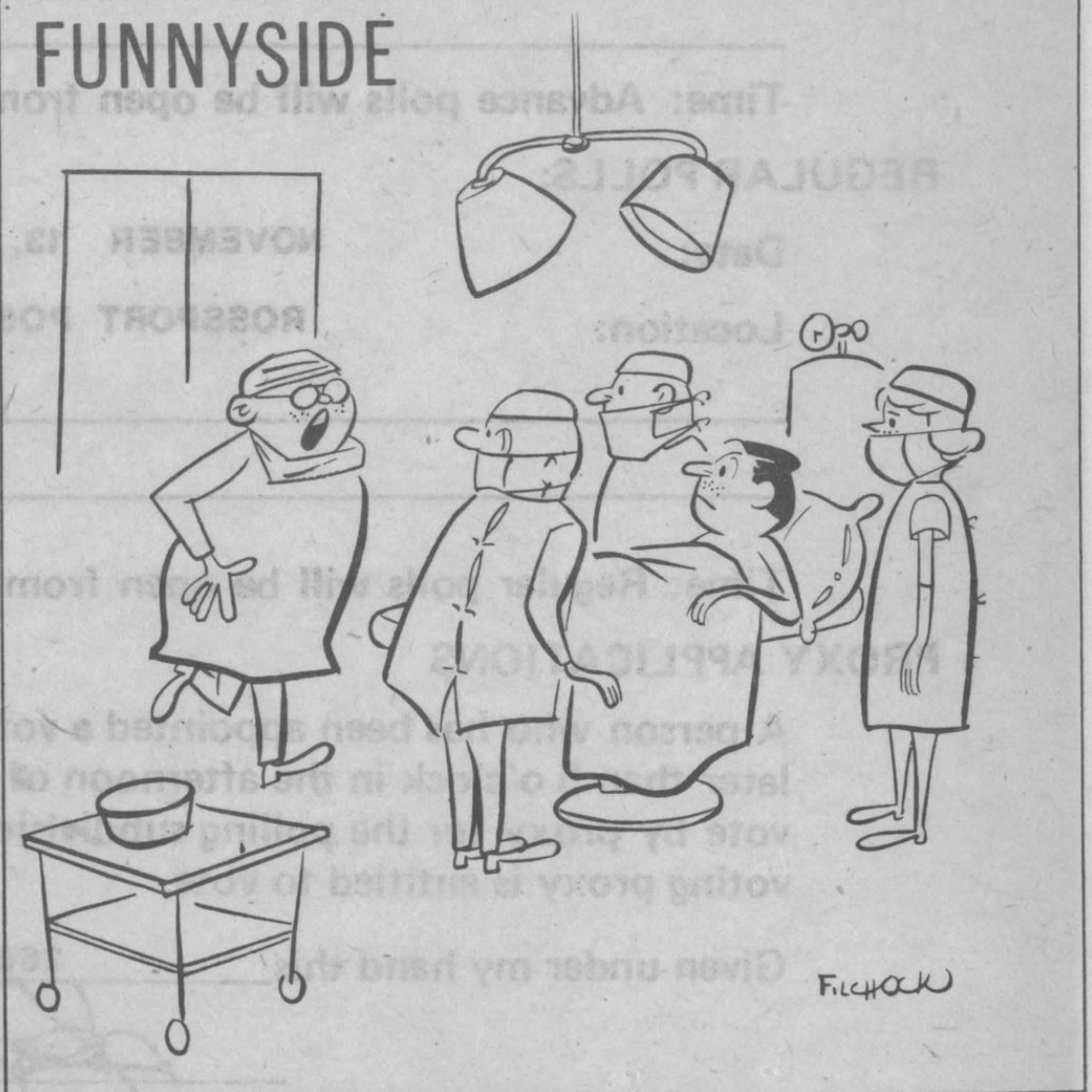
garding water draining into ratepayer's yards.
