

HOMES FOR THE AGED MONTHLY MEETING

The monthly meeting of the Board of Management of the District of Thunder Bay Home for the Aged was held at Pinewood Court on December 8th, with five Board Members in attendance.

The Board spent considerable time on the Operating Budget for Pinewood Court and Birchwood Terrace for the year beginning April 1st, 1979 to March 31st, 1980. Pinewood Court's total budget will be \$836,577.00 and Birchwood Terrace's budget will be \$478,287.00. This will result in the same per diem rate as in the past year of \$23.00 per day. There were four bids for the heating oil at Birchwood Terrace. The ten-

ders were very close with Shell being the successful Tender.

The Administrator was authorized to enter into an Agreement with Great Lakes Paper for a computer service. The computer service will be able to handle both payrolls for Pinewood Court and Birchwood Terrace as of January 1st, 1979.

The Chairman, Mrs. Lillian Morrow, explained a letter and brochure she had received from the Minister, Mr. Keith Norton, explaining the changes that will be made in the Ministry during the next three years. The present Ministry will be split into two sections, namely, Adult Services and Children Services. Mr. Lawrence Crawford, the present Director has a senior position in Adult Services heading the Gerontology Section.
