

Most people use guns responsibly... a few don't.



Canada's gun laws require that anyone wishing to purchase, borrow or exchange a firearm obtain a Firearms Acquisition Certificate from police.

Certificates cost \$10.00 and are valid anywhere in Canada for five years, allowing the purchase of any number of guns with a single certificate during the five year period.

The purpose of the new law is to ensure that guns are not made readily available to those with a history of violent behavior, mental disorders or a criminal record involving violence.

YOU DO NOT NEED A FIREARMS ACQUISITION CERTIFICATE FOR GUNS YOU ALREADY OWN, OR TO PURCHASE AMMUNITION.
