The meeting adjourned and lunch was served by Mrs. Irene Moorey and her committee.

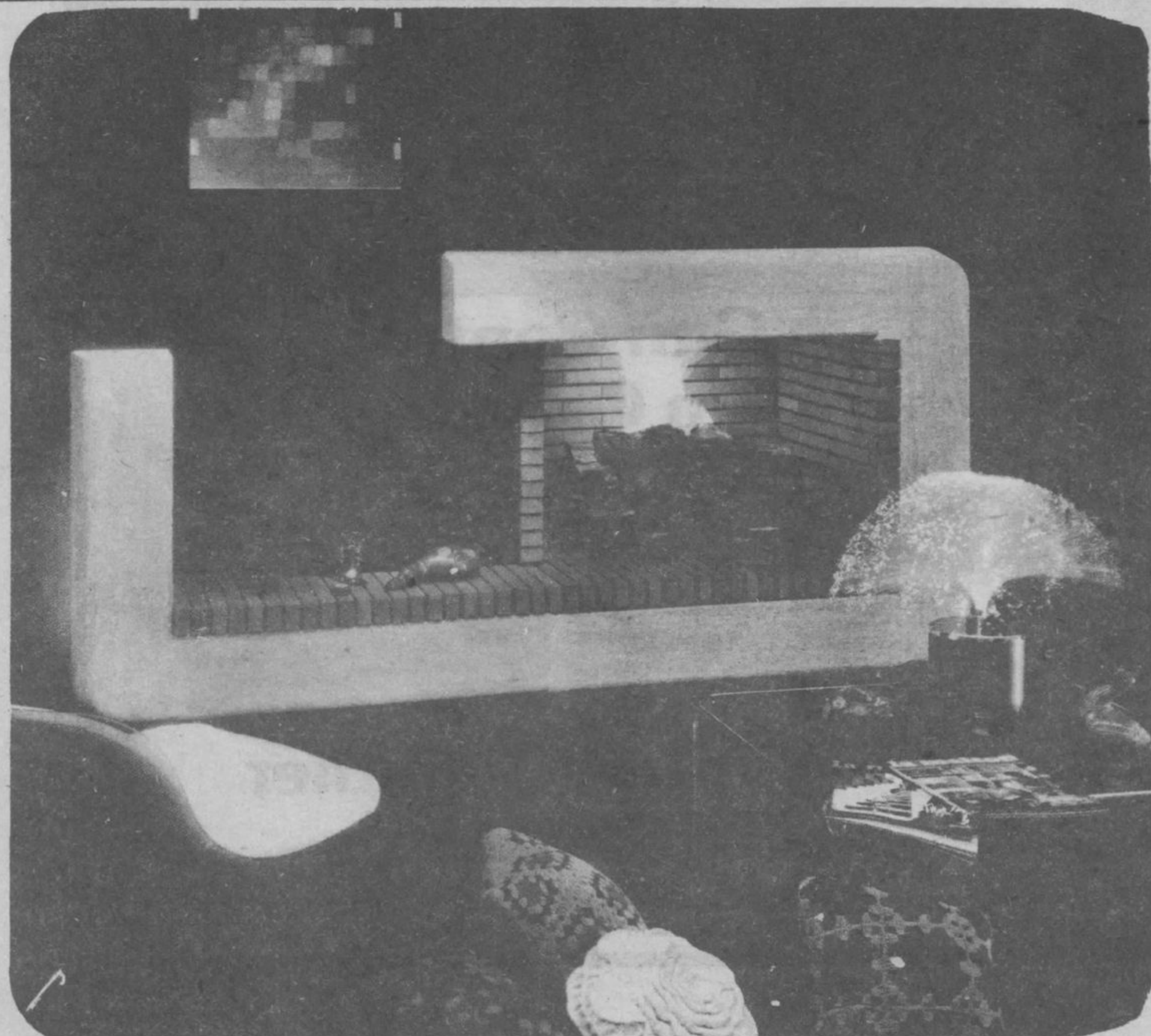
O'BRIEN:
