

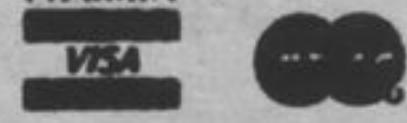

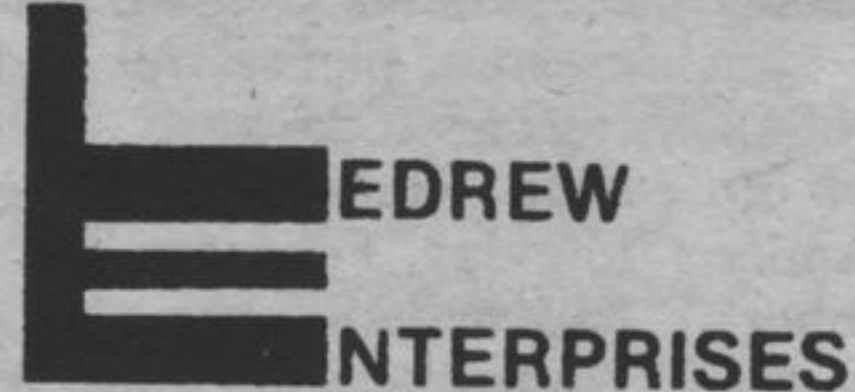

as this one," she said. "Quite apart from the usual functions of such Boards, such as approving disbursements of funds, setting policy and terms of employment etc., this Board has strong and workable ideas as to the direction probation and correctional services in general should go in the months and years to come. They want community involvement in the justice system and are prepared to spend some of their own very valuable time to ensure that our communities have input into the way the Courts work for us here."

Mrs. Cooper went on

to point out that the Corrections Committee's Annual Meeting will be held early in March and anyone interested in the local justice system is encouraged to attend and become a part of this unique community-based program. New members are also being sought for the Community Corrections Board. For further information on the Committee, call Mrs. Cooper at 824-3036.

Mrs. Cooper commented that the program for the past nine months has seen a good measure of success. "We have had only one instance where a per-

son ordered to perform community service work did not fulfill his hours, and this matter will be dealt with in the Court, but all the other probationers on the program (approximately twenty with community service orders) have not only fulfilled the number of hours of work prescribed by the Court, but have done so in good spirits and with great effort. Almost one thousand hours of free volunteer work have been provided to the community by these probationers ... work in the recreation center, schools, library, Churches in both communities, and township crews ... work which benefits both the community and the offender. Community Corrections is a good programme and I hope some people may find themselves interested enough to come out to our Annual Meeting and find out if they would like to become involved with our Board."
