

Homes for Aged monthly meeting

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Management of the District of Thunder Bay Homes for the Aged was held at Birchwood Terrace, Terrace Bay. The meeting opened with the Chairman, Alex Dan-eff, requesting a period of silence in respect of Gordon Waghorn, former Reeve of Nipigon and the first Chairman of the District Board. He was on the Board during the building of Pinewood Court and the conversion of Birchwood Terrace. Mr. Waghorn's funeral was held in Nipigon on Saturday, February 19, 1983.

The meeting dealt with a heavy agenda of sixteen resolutions. Operating accounts for the month of January were approved totalling \$146,159.28. Six applications for residence were approved, three for each Home. There are ten vacancies available in Birchwood Terrace and one in Pinewood Court. Applicants are not facing long waiting lists.

The estimated operating budget for the period April 1, 1983 to March 31, 1984 totalling \$1,880,300.00 and the estimated capital budget of \$41,150.00 were approved. This is subject to the approval of the Ministry of Community and Social Services. The Municipal operating budget of \$1,880,300.00 and the capital budget of \$41,150.00 were approved as recommended by the Finance Committee. This will require a Municipal levy of \$171,516.72 calculated according to the equalized assessment report.

A number of tenders were approved. In Pinewood Court Pierce Flor-

craft in the amount of \$930.00 was approved for the installation of Corlon to two corridor walls. The tender of Canadian Rogers Western Limited for a replacement of the sterilizer totalling \$3,089.00 was approved. From the donations account, Final Touch was the successful bidder for drapes totalling \$719.76. The Board approved an increase of 5 per cent in the residential per diem rate from \$29.00 per day to \$30.45. This is effective April 1, 1983. All full pay residents will be informed of this change. Rent increases of 5 per cent were approved for the rental apartments at Birchwood Terrace. Two requests for leave of absence were approved as recommended by the Director of Nursing, Mrs. P. Flaherty.

The Administrator, M.J. Vibert, reported on the progress with the energy conservation improvements at Birchwood Terrace. It is possible the improvements in insulating the northern exposure of the building will be done from the outside, rather than from the inside as originally proposed. The financial audit for 1982 has been completed and the reports have been forwarded to Board members and each participating Municipality.

The next board meeting will be held in Pinewood Court on March 25, 1983 followed by the Annual Meeting at 7:00 p.m. to which the participating Municipalities are invited to send a delegate. Appointments to the Board of Management are finalized at this meeting.

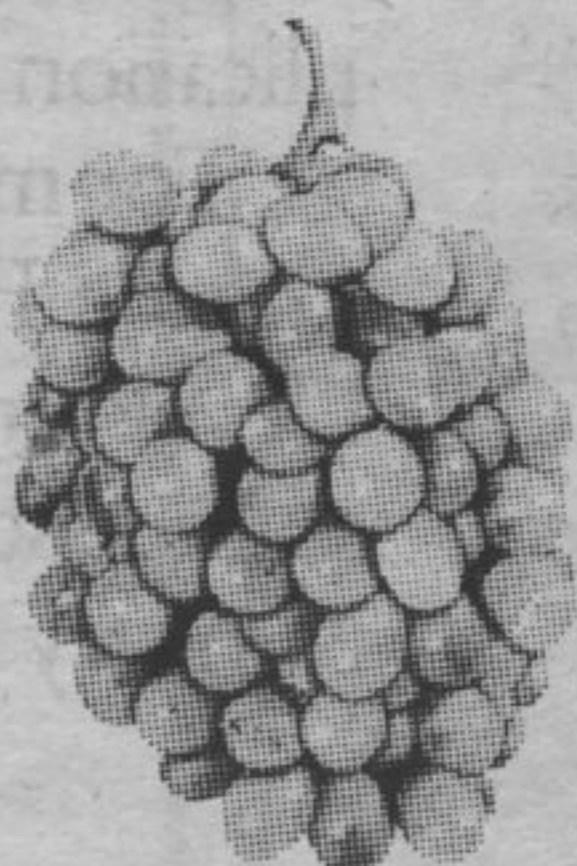
