

First Tiny Tournament

PUBLIC NOTICE Dog Control By-Law

By-Law No. 342 of the Township of Terrace Bay provides in part as follows:

"No person shall permit his dog to run at large in the Township except when on a chain or lead and under the immediate charge and control of some competent person".

'A dog shall be deemed to be running at large when found in any place other than the premises of the owner, possessor or harbourer and not under the control of any person."

"Any dog found running at large may be impounded by the authorized person finding it." "It shall be the duty of the Animal Control Officer to enforce this

by-law." Penalties up to \$50.00 are provided and the By-Law will be strictly enforced by Wayne Papineau - 825-9417.
