

## Hilda's Fixins

Cranberry-orange Glazed Cornish with Rice Cakes

4 Cornish game hens, thawed 1/2 cup marg., melted

Glaze 1/2 cup whole berry cranberry sauce 1/2 cup orange marmalade 1/2 cup mandarin orange segments

3 tbsp. lemon juice 1 tbsp. instant minced onion

Rice Cakes

2 cups cooked Riceland extra long grain rice 1/2 cup minced onion 2 eggs 3 tbsp flour salt and pepper to taste Rinse hens and pat dry. Coat inside and out with butter, sprinkle with salt and pepper. Place hens on rack in shallow roasting pan. Roast in preheated oven at 425 degrees for 15 minutes, reduce heat to 375 degrees and roast 45 minutes to 1 hour longer, basting occasionally

with drippings. Mean-

while, combine glaze ingredients. During last 20 minutes of roasting, brush hens with glaze several times. Glaze again before serving. Meanwhile, in large bowl, combine rice cake mixture. Drop mixture by 1/4 cupfuls into hot oil in skillet. Fry on each side till golden brown and crispy. Sprinkle with Paprika or parsley flakes. - (makes 8 cakes)

Handy Tips

Prevent grubby fingertips on doorknobs, wall switchplates and the areas around such fixtures by spraying the areas with liquid wax polish or coating them with paste wax.

Never water plants with cold water. Use water at room temperature, to avoid shock to the roots. If you can, let the water stand overnight, so the chlorine will sink to the bottom. Chlorine may not hurt most plants, but it doesn't do them any good either.
