Bean Pie

1 unbaked 9" pie shell 1 cup sugar [1/2 cup white, 1/2 cup brown] 1/3 cup butter or margarine

cup cooked navy beans, pureed or mashed smooth

2 eggs 2/3 cup evaporated milk 2 tsps. cinnamon 2 tsps. cornstarch

2 drops yellow food colouring 1/3 tsp. lemon extract

2/3 tsp. vanilla extract

Cream butter and sugars, add cinnamon and cornstarch. Beat in one egg at a time, add beans and milk and blend until smooth. Blend in food colouring and flavouring. Pour into unbaked pie shell and bake in preheated 400

utes. Reduce heat to 350 deg., and bake 45 more minutes. Pie is done when tester inserted in center comes out clean. This tastes like a pecan pie.


Handy Tips

very cooperative and we as a Council appreciated very much their joining with us in this effort by sponsoring the ad in last week's paper promoting the Clean-Up".






