A special meeting in Marathon to approve the Board was held improve the 1983 bud-

get.  
The Collective Agreement between the Lake Superior Board of Education and the elementary

teachers (Local OPSTF and FWTAO) (1982-84) as negotiated by the salary committee was accepted as presented. Trustees G. Bodak, D. Burton, J. Nugent and M. Reid abstained from voting on this issue due to possible conflict of interest.

The Board approved the Secondary Revenue and Expenditure Estimates for 1983 in the amount of \$1,186,107.00 which is exclusive of salaries and benefits. (Recorded vote: For: 9; Against:3).

The Board approved the Elementary Revenue and Expen-

diture Estimates for 1983 in the amount of \$909,484 which is exclusive of salaries and benefits. (Recorded vote: For: 5; Against: 3).

The Board approved the Secondary 1983 budget for salaries and benefits of \$3,312,854. (Recorded vote: For:8; Abstain: due to possible conflict of interests: G. Bodak, D. Burton, J. Nugent and M. Reid).

The Board approved the Elementary 1983 budget for salaries and benefits of \$2,551,603. (Recorded vote: For: 6; Abstain: due to possible conflict of interest: G. Bodak, D. Burton, J. Nugent and M. Reid).

The Board approved the 1983 Secondary tax requisition of \$1,617,974. (Recorded vote: For: 9; Against:3).

The Board approved the 1983 Elementary tax requisition of \$1,681,311. (Recorded vote: For: 5;

Against: 3).

The Board approved the following monthly vehicle allowances for the Maintenance Working Foremen, effective May 1, 1983: Schreiber/Terrace Bay - \$399.00; Marathon and Manitowadge - \$199.50 each.

The Board approved the establishment of a one-semester short-term appointment from February 1, 1984 to June 30, 1984, inclusive for the position of Computers in Education Co-ordinator as per the proposal of the Board's Computer Advisory Committee.

The following personnel issues were resolved:

- the request for transfer of Mr. Kerry Powell from his teaching assignment at Marathon High School to Lake Superior High School, effective September 1, 1983 was approved,
- the resignation of Mrs. Sue Hurley, teacher for Lake Superior High School, was accepted with regret effective August 31, 1983,
- the appointment of Mrs. Anne Wilkes to half-time teaching duties at Terrace Bay Public School was approved, effective September 1, 1983 at salary according to schedule.
