

Womans's Solo Cross - Canada run

Kanchan Stott not only will be the first woman to run across Canada, but if she is successful, she will have set a world record for the longest distance that has been run by a woman.

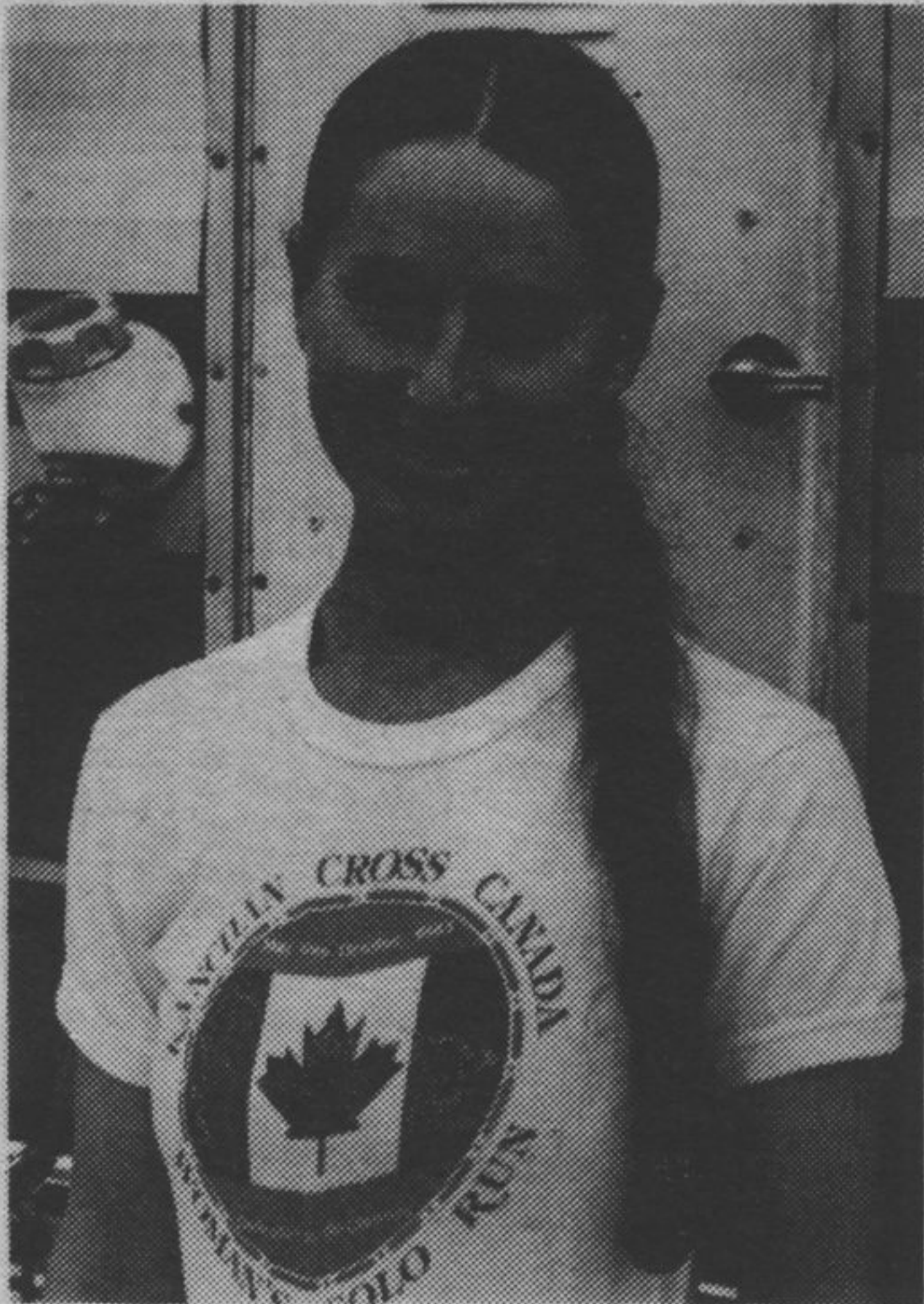
Kanchan who is 37 years old and in top-notch physical and mental condition began her run on May 6th, 1983 in Victoria, B.C. She arrived in Schreiber on Sunday, August 21st and in Terrace Bay shortly after. Kanchan currently holds the Canadian Championship record for the longest distance run in a 24-hour race (106 miles, 400 yards). Stott has run numerous marathon races in such centres as Ottawa, New York and Maine.

She points out that she does not consider herself to be a marathon runner, instead she classifies herself as an "ultra-distance" runner. "It's different from marathon running as the goal of ultra-distance running is to keep the body calm, economical and restrained."

Kanchan is part of the Sri Chinmoy Marathon Team and through Sri Chinmoy, and his philosophy which centres on meditation and self-transcendence, she is able to push herself beyond imagined boundaries.

"Meditation has taught me to be peaceful and calm," she says, "despite the odds and pain." The run which is being monitored will finish in Halifax, Nova Scotia hopefully by October.

Kanchan Stott is currently employed as a music teacher with the Ottawa Board of Education.

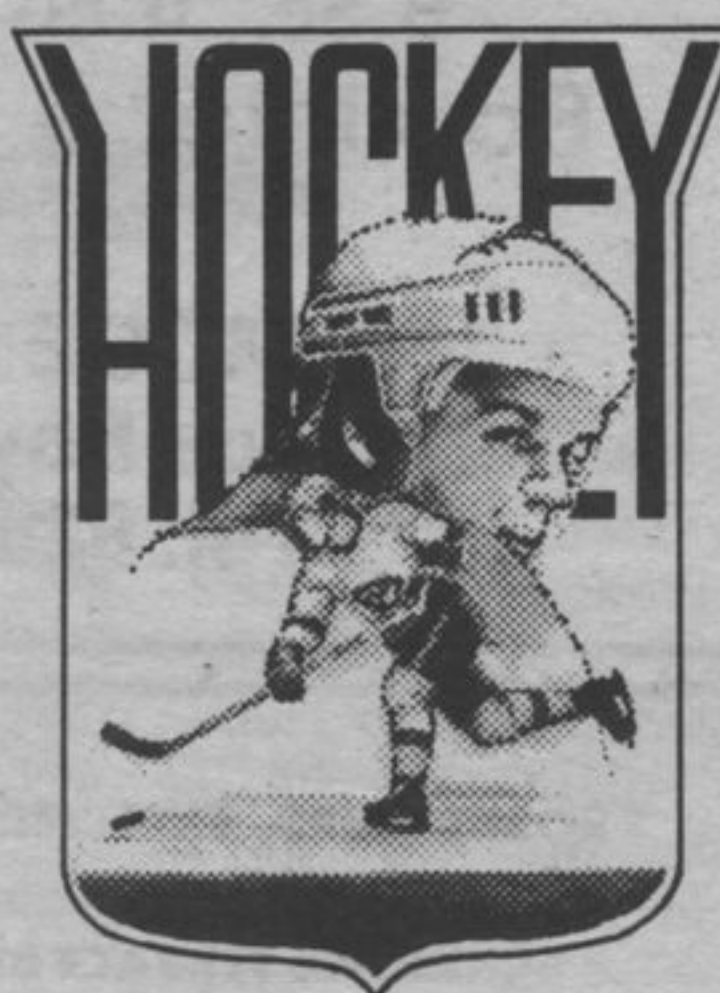
