## Bursary

Eighteen bursaries will be awarded later this year to graduate students in the fields of speech pathology, social work and psychometry to enhance the number of professionals providing services in Northern Ontario.

Frank Drea, Minister of Community and Social Services and Leo Bernier, Minister of Northern Affairs today announced the continuation of the \$90,000 Northern Bursary Assistance Program which started in 1981.

"Through this program, graduate students are being encouraged to enter employment in underserved areas of northern Ontario," said Drea. "It's also an excellent way of getting some valuable experience."

The program, funded by Northern Affairs and administered by Community and Social Services, is available to Ontario residents who are completing graduate studies in those disciplines from universities across Canada.

The bursaries, six in each of the disciplines, are in the amount of \$5,000 each per year of study for a maximum of two years.

Successful applicants must, however, agree to one year of employment upon graduation in a social service agency within the Northern part of the province for each year of bursary assistance granted.
